Journeys is an early intervention creative health programme developed in partnership with NHS Gloucestershire ICB and Young Minds Matter through the Trailblazer Programme.

The programme supports children and young people aged 7–14 who may be experiencing low mood or challenges with their wellbeing and self-esteem. Through creative activities, Journeys provides opportunities to build confidence, develop resilience, and improve emotional wellbeing in a safe and supportive environment.

Journeys is delivered in schools across Gloucestershire, within community settings, and through bespoke one-to-one programmes.

Courses for Children and Young People - Xpres!



Xpres! is a creative health programme co-produced with Gloucestershire NHS ICB, young people, and clinicians, and delivered in partnership with Art Shape and The Music Works.

The programme supports young people aged 8–18 living with a long-term health condition, helping them build confidence, develop new skills, enjoy creative experiences, and form lasting friendships in a supportive environment.

In the Forest of Dean, Xpres! offers a range of activities including aerial circus, circus skills, pottery (including wheel throwing), and arts and crafts.

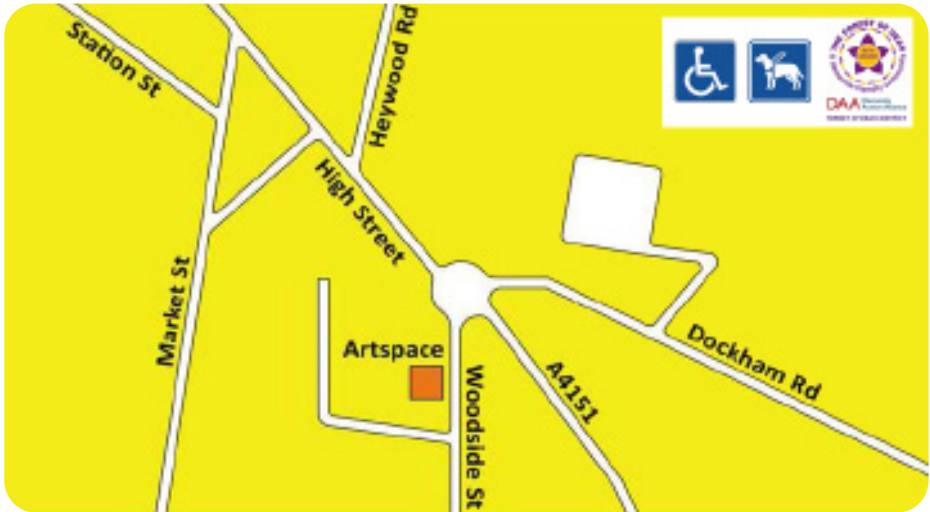
